HOURS OF OPERATION*

The Trolley operates seven days a week and runs on the half-hour with extended weekend hours.

Monday - Thursday

12:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m.

Friday & Saturday

12:00 p.m. - 1:00 a.m.

Sunday

12:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

We are closed:

New Year's Day (January 1)
Thanksgiving Day
(fourth Thursday in November)
Christmas Day (December 25)

PASSENGER RULES

- Remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- When you wish to depart the bus, notify the bus operator in advance by pulling the overhead cord.
- When departing, please do not walk in front of the bus. Wait until the bus departs so you can look both ways to safely cross the street.
- Only radios with earphones allowed.
- No food or drink in open containers is allowed.
- No littering or smoking is allowed.

PASSENGER TIPS

- Plan your trip and inform a family member, friend or co-worker of your route and travel times.
- Keep your purse, shopping bag or other valuables on your lap or arm or between your feet.
- Alert your bus operator immediately to any unsafe conditions on the bus or at any bus stop.
- Call WATA at 757-220-5493 for assistance or to report any concerns.

FARES

Exact fare only. Trolley operators do not carry change or currency.

Standard fare (ages 13-59) **\$0.50**

Persons 60 and over **\$0.25**

Persons with disabilities (with Medicare card) **\$0.25**

Children 12 and under accompanied by paying adult **Free**

William & Mary and Thomas Nelson college students with student ID **Free**

Middle and high school students with student ID and residing in James City County, the City of Williamsburg and York County **Free**

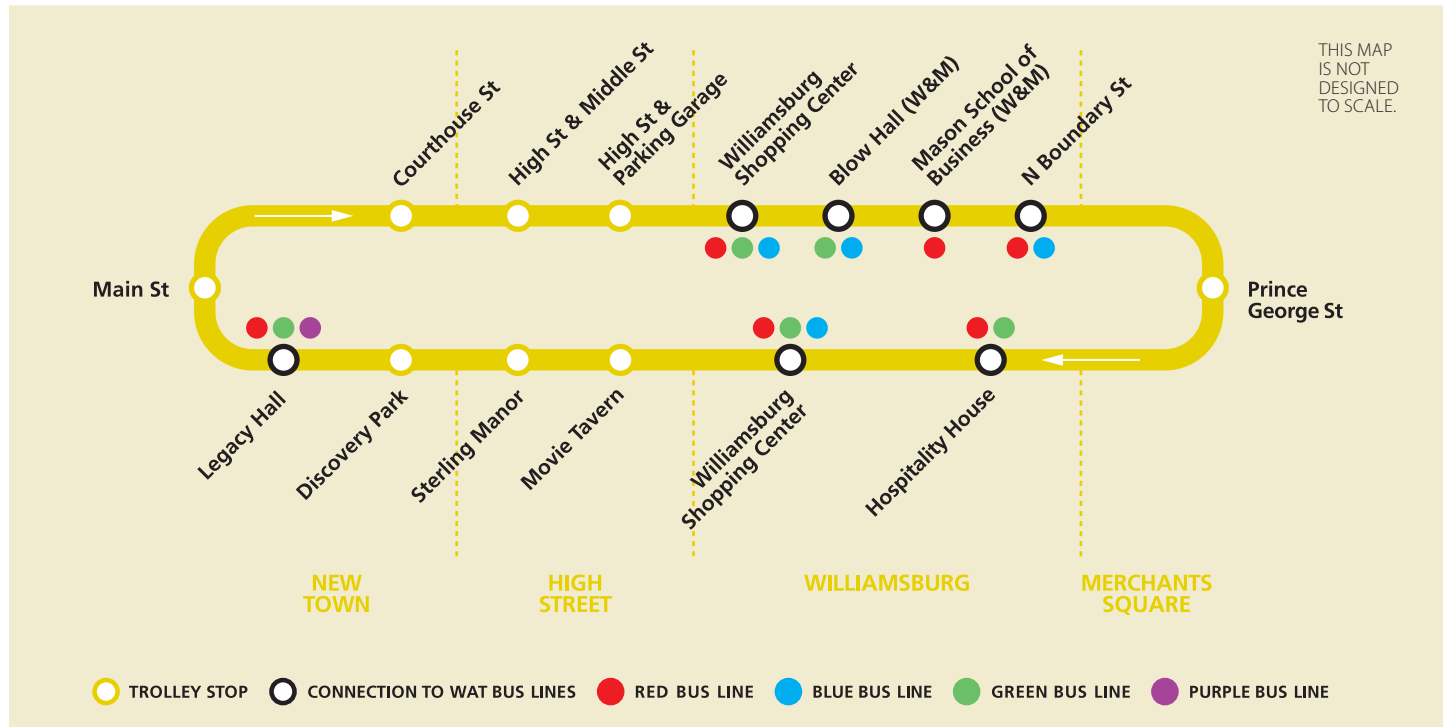
